

EGR 193: The Virtual Internship Experience

EGR 193 is a summer-only course designed for students who have not otherwise secured an internship/co-op. The experience is designed to expose students to networking opportunities, social and professional development, as well as building technical skills.

Content is delivered through a combination of:

- Course text and assignments/reflections
- Employer or Center-led Seminars and Workshops
- Employer-led mini projects or Individual projects
- Networking experiences

Frequently Asked Questions:

- What course will I enroll in?
 - EGR 193: Section 1 is for students just finishing their first or second year at MSU, Section 2 is for students just finishing their third year or above.
- What is the cost for EGR 193?
 - Similar to the other EGR X courses, students will receive a scholarship that covers the cost of tuition, plus half of any engineering fee applied for the semester of enrollment.
- Is EGR 193 Virtual or In-Person?
 - Most of the EGR 193 seminars and projects are held virtually. There are also optional, in-person, offerings in select geographical locations throughout the summer. Students can complete the entire EGR 193 course virtually, if desired. All work will be submitted via D2L.
- What is the time commitment?
 - Students will need to commit approximately 6-10 hours per week on average. Students have a degree of flexibility to spread hours throughout the summer to complete requirements.
- When is the course held?
 - The course is held starting in mid-June each year and runs 8-weeks until early-August. Individual sessions and projects will be a combination of asynchronous and synchronous. Synchronous sessions will be offered at consistent times each week to aid students in planning and scheduling.

- Does EGR 193 count towards the EGR X Waiver?
 - No. Only EGR 391-EGR 494 count towards the EGR X Waiver.

- Will I be paid for the virtual internship experience?
 - No. This is a for-credit experience only.
