

Getting Started & Usage Tips

Log On & Upload Your Resume @ <http://www.vmock.com/msuengineers>

- Enter your university email address and password to access the VMock student dashboard
- From the student dashboard, begin working on your resume by uploading a PDF
 - No resume? You can use the “create new” button to get started
- After the upload, your resume will be processed, and you will receive your initial score
- Scoring: The system looks at three areas of your resume
 - **Presentation** (formatting, spelling, and grammar)
 - **Competencies** (skills - how you get work done)
 - **Impact** (outcomes associated with your experiences)



Don't panic if you're in the **red zone**. The prompts will guide you!

Resume Scoring & Editing

- Receive your score and click on “**View Detailed Feedback**” (remember, resumes are subjective - this is AI/ML sharing some suggestions...we humans can also help you!)
- Select “**Smart Edit**” and start working with VMock on options to improve your Presentation, Competencies, and Impact; aim to get into the “Green Zone” - that’s a score of 80 or higher
- Rescore Your Resume - Enjoy what happens! The goal is to get to a score of 80 - don’t sweat it if you struggle a bit to improve - take the time, read the suggestions, you will get there!
- Make sure you make all of the changes before you rescore, each rescore counts against your total uploads.

Download Your Resume

- Download your resume in PDF or Docx and upload it to Handshake to start applying for jobs.

Optimize Your Resume for Job Postings

- Resume Optimization - Upload a job description and your resume for optimization and the system will help you align your resume with the job! Use the “Smart Editor” to make adjustments
